383. Book location: "He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit."

384. Book location: A companion to Ephesians, this book focuses on the head of the Church.

385. Book location: Paul's letter that teaches the correct way to observe the Lord's Supper.

386. Book location: Describes the Christian's armor and weapon.

387. Book location: "All Scripture is inspired by God and is profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work."

405. Book location: "Therefore to one who knows the right thing to do and does not do it, to him it is sin."

406. Book location: What book centers around comments concerning Gaius, Diotrephes, and Demetrius?

407. Book location: Book key words: perfect (14); eternal/forever (15); better (13); partakers (9); heaven (17); priest (32).

408. NT book location: Contains the chapter listing the faithful.

409. Book location: Stresses sound speech and control of the tongue.

410. Book location: Lists more titles for Christ than any book in the New Testament.

411. Book location: "God, after he spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, in these last days has spoken to us in His son..."

412. Book location: Begins with letters to 7 churches.

413. Book location: "Contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all handed down to the saints."

414. Book location: Exhorts the elders to shepherd the flock; calls himself a "fellow elder."

415. Book location: "For if we go on sinning after receiving the knowledge of the truth there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins."

416. Addresses his readers as "my little children."

417. Book location: Speaks of adding to your faith: moral excellence, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, brotherly kindness, Christian love.

418. Book location: "We know that we have passed out of death into life because we love the brethren. He who does not love abides in death."

419. Book location: "For there are three that bear witness, the Spirit and the water and the blood; and these three are in agreement."
