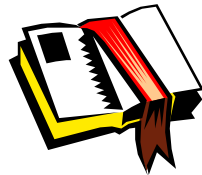

What is the Bible Comp Exam?

The Bible Comprehensive Exam is established by the Faculty and maintained by the Division of Bible Faculty. It covers the major sections of Biblical literature plus Old Testament and New Testament Introduction. A passing score is getting at least 130 out of the 150 questions correct.



The exam has 150 questions that as much as possible reflect general factual knowledge. It is not based on an individual professor's interpretation of

given passages. The following sections covered are: Old Testament Introduction, Pentateuch, History Books, Devotional books, Major Prophets, Minor Prophets, New Testament Introduction, Gospels, Acts, Pauline Epistles, and General Epistles. The test offers five possible answers for each question. Answers are entered on a "bubble" answer sheet that has been pre-marked into the eleven sections of the exam.

You are allowed to take the test 3 times during an Academic year. Do not wait until the last minute and stress yourself out.

HOW DO I REGISTER?

If you have enough credits to be considered a Junior or a Senior (at least 64), then you are eligible to take this exam.

Test-takers register for BCE 421. All registrations can be done on-line through the SOLAR System.

WHERE CAN I GET A COPY OF THE NEW AND IMPROVED STUDY GUIDE?

The Bible Comprehensive Exam and companion Study Guide were evaluated and updated June 2006. The Study Guide has 426 questions. Each of these questions are on at least one form of the test. You can get a paper copy of the Study Guide from the Registrar's Office or you can download it from our website, www.fcc.edu. Be
